

VOCATIONAL NURSING (LVN) Applicants for the Spring 2025 program

The program of study for the Certificate of Achievement in Vocational Nursing is designed to prepare students for employment in acute care facilities, clinics, long care facilities, physician offices, home, and health centers. The LVN Program of the Adams Center is a full, three-semester, 18-month course of instruction which leads to a certificate in vocational nursing and 40.5 units college credit. The program is accredited by the California Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians. Students who complete the program take a state examination for licensure in vocational nursing.

All applicants must complete an application for the Vocational Nursing Program. These applications will be provided at the orientation

1) PROGRAM COURSE WORK:

- Students are given classroom instruction and related hospital experience for approximately 30 hours per semester. Semester One: 2.5 units Semester Two: 3.5 units Semester Three: 4.5 units (Total: 40.5)

2) ADMISSION TO THE LVN PROGRAM REQUIRES:

1. Attend ONE mandatory program orientation (Register for a Zoom in www.ccsf.edu/LVN)
2. An official U.S. accredited high school transcript showing completion of grade 11 or U.S. high school equivalent.
3. Completion of college level Algebra course or higher
4. Have an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher
5. Recency requirement: Complete the following prerequisites (or acceptable equivalents) within 5 years prior to enrollment.
 - Better in the US or regionally/nationally accredited
 - (1) Anatomy & Physiology course - 4 units (e.g. BIO 6 or both)
